Nanny pass allows you to add a nanny to your family membership. This person will only be admitted as a nanny for your children and may not accompany you when visiting the pool. You may add as many nannies as you wish. However, only one (1) nanny at a time will be admitted per visit.

Rescheduling Policy

Lessons will not be rescheduled for personal reasons. If the lesson was canceled due to weather or an unforeseen closure of the pool, the lesson director will try to coordinate a make-up lesson. This does not guarantee that the make-up lesson will be at the same time or day of the week as the originally scheduled lesson.

Pool Rules

- Everyone entering the facility must pay or provide a pool pass; this also applies to those not intending to swim.
- All patrons entering the pool deck or pool must be wearing a lined swimsuit. No street shoes/clothes allowed on pool deck.
- Ages 10 and under must be accompanied by an adult 18 or older at all times.
- Small children must be in arm's length of a parent/guardian at all times when in the water.
- No outside food or beverage allowed. Food and drink is only permitted in the concession area.
- Coolers and glass containers are not allowed in the facility.
- Persons with open sores, casts, bandages, or skin rash may not enter the facility.
- Showers are recommended before entering the pool.
- Children who are not toilet trained must wear an Aqua Diaper.
- Only USCG approved life jackets or other uniformly balanced non-inflatable flotation devices may be used in the pool. Some other flotation devices may be used in baby pool area but for safety reasons the on-duty manager has the final decision.
- Horse-play and running are not allowed.
- Patrons must be able to easily swim the width of the pool using a freestyle stroke to be allowed in-between the deep end ropes.
- Riverside Family Aquatic Center is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- Riverside Family Aquatic Center is a smoke-free facility.
- Lifeguards have an important job to do, please do not distract them while they are on duty.
- Failure to follow directions and/or rules will result in ejection from the facility.
- No refunds, No exceptions.
