

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES FOR “CRAYON CREATIONS ART SHOW”

- Crayon Creations Art Show is an Open-Submission show for patrons of all ages
- There will be no prizes given for this event – all art submitted to this event is meant to be displayed and celebrated. *This is not a contest.*
- Art can be created by a single artist or a group.
- 1 submission per person or group will be accepted.
- Art must be a 3-Dimensional piece containing crayons. Other mediums can be used to shape the crayons and hold them in place, however there must be AT LEAST ONE CRAYON.
 - **NOTE: Crayons are not required to be Crayola brand.**
- Art must be an original piece of your design celebrating crayons or an homage to a favorite art piece – we are looking to showcase artists and their ideas.
- Art piece should not exceed a 12” x 12” base.
- There is no limit on height, however artists are responsible for transporting their piece safely to and from the Moline Public Library.
- Art deemed inappropriate will be given back to the artist and not considered for the final art show.
- Upon submittal, the artist accepts that their art will be shown on the Moline Public Library webpage and various social media.
- Submissions will be accepted at the Moline Public Library Children’s Desk.
- Submissions will be accepted from March 18th – 25th, at which time submissions will be closed
- ***ARTISTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR PICKING UP THEIR ART BEFORE APRIL 8TH, AT WHICH TIME ALL ART WILL BE DISPOSED OF.***
