

Comic Celebration Art Contest!

“Celebrating our favorite comics and graphic novels from all over the multiverse! Show us your favorite characters, scenes or universes, or make something entirely new! Art will be displayed at the Moline Public Library for the public to see and vote on! Submissions accepted from April 3rd – 29th “

Criteria:

- One entry per person or group
- Any medium accepted – no framed artwork
 - Art can be either 2-Dimensional or 3-Dimensional
 - No full comic books accepted, however if the piece is deconstructed and attached to a black poster board that is acceptable.
- Art piece should not exceed a 12” x 12” base.
- There is no limit on height, however artists are responsible for transporting their piece safely to and from the Moline Public Library.
- Any subject following the theme, must be G-rated
 - Theme: “Comic Celebration!”
 - NOTE: Fan art is accepted and encouraged
 - Art deemed inappropriate will be given back to the artist and not considered for the final judging.
- Must be original, previously unpublished artwork – plagiarized works will be disqualified
- Upon submission, artist must provide First & Last name, age, phone number and email
- Upon submission, the artist accepts that their art will be shown on the Moline Public Library webpage and various social media.
- Submissions will be accepted at the Moline Public Library Children’s Desk

Age Groups:

This contest is open to the following, and will be judged within their specific age groups:

Grades K-2, 3-5, 6-8

High School (9-12)

Ages 18+

Entry Dates: Art must be submitted *NO LATER THAN April 29th at 5:00pm*. Art may be dropped off at the Children's Desk or emailed to bhager@molinelibrary.org. If your art is not submitted by this time, it will not be part of the contest.

Showcase: April 30th – May 6th

Winners announced: May 13th via Moline Library Website and social media. Winners will be contacted via telephone or email.

ARTISTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR PICKING UP THEIR ART BEFORE THE END OF THE DAY ON MAY 20th, AT WHICH TIME ALL ART WILL BE DISPOSED OF.
