

Build-A-Droid Art Contest!

“Celebrate your love of Star Wars comics for Free Comic Book Day! Build your own droid using any medium - they can be stationary 3-D models, 2-D drawings or schematics, or fully-working droids. The galaxy's the limit! What kinds of droids will you make? Art will be displayed at the Moline Public Library for the public to see and vote on! Submissions accepted from April 1st – 27th “

Criteria:

- One entry per person or group
 - Group submissions accepted - please come up with a team name and provide all team members' names upon sign-up with one person as designated contact
- Any medium accepted – no framed artwork
 - Art can be either 2-Dimensional or 3-Dimensional
 - 2-Dimensional art can be a full drawing or painting of an original droid, or schematics of an original droid, designed by the artist. Must be attached to a black or white backboard.
 - Plagiarized work will not be accepted
 - 3-Dimensional art can be made of any medium, and can be either stationary or mobile. Fully-working droids must be noted as such.
 - Premade droids from retail stores and Disney's Star Wars Galaxy's Edge will not be accepted, unless they are fully repainted in a different style and color.
 - Additions of scratches, wiring, etc. are encouraged, however the droid itself must also be repainted by the artist.
 - Should your droid be mobile or make noise, artists are encouraged to demonstrate the mobility of their droid and how to power it up or down.
- Art piece should not exceed a 18" x 18" base.
- There is no limit on height, however artists are responsible for transporting their piece safely to and from the Moline Public Library.

- Art deemed inappropriate will be given back to the artist and not considered for the final judging.
- Must be original, previously unpublished artwork – plagiarized works will be disqualified
- Upon submission, artist must provide First & Last name, age, phone number and email.
 - This is to contact the winner after judging has concluded. No information will be kept by the Moline Public Library after the event.
- Upon submission, the artist accepts that their art will be shown on the Moline Public Library webpage and various social media.
- Submissions will be accepted at the Moline Public Library Children’s Desk

Age Groups:

This contest is open to the following, and will be judged within their specific age groups:

- Grades K-2, 3-5, 6-8
- High School (grades 9 - 12) - Adults (18+)

Entry Dates: Art must be submitted *NO LATER THAN April 27th at 5:00pm*. Art may be dropped off at the Children’s Desk or emailed to bhager@molinelibrary.org. If your art is not submitted by this time, it will not be part of the contest.

Showcase: April 29th – May 4th

Winners announced: May 11th via Moline Library Website and social media. Winners will be contacted via telephone or email.

ARTISTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR PICKING UP THEIR ART BEFORE THE END OF THE DAY ON MAY 18th, AT WHICH TIME ALL ART WILL BE DISPOSED OF.
